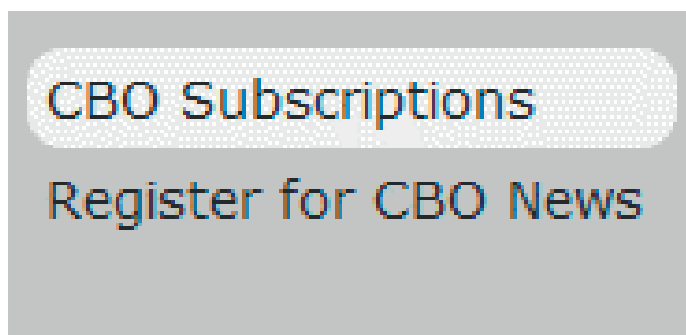
We do appreciate that this is causing a real problem for some of our regular subscribers. At the moment all subscriptions are frozen until we see what the future brings.
